Thank you for the prompt return of the file of our case against the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct.


Notwithstanding the opening sentence of your three-sentence March 28th note--a copy of which is annexed for your convenience--I find it hard to believe that Professor Dershowitz, who invited me to send him the case file less than two weeks earlier, should have asked you to send it back.

Indeed, it appears from the pristine, uncreased condition of my three-page March 20th coverletter addressed to the Professor--which was enclosed with your return--that it was never read by anyone--let alone by the Professor. The same is true of the file. Certainly, it is hard to imagine that the Professor could have read the coverletter and perused the file and reacted by directing that they be sent back--without the slightest comment about them.

Given what my coverletter described--that we have been utterly unable to find a lawyer to handle an important public interest case, involving issues the Professor has gone on record as caring enormously about--I believe that even were the Professor too busy to handle the case himself, he would have ensured that a lawyer were found for us. I have no doubt but that the Professor knows lots and lots of lawyers--and even some who are courageous enough for the kind of politically explosive, high-profile case as it represented by our litigation against the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct.

I, therefore, am sending the original transmittal back to the Professor so that a disposition can be made consistent with what he stands for.
