Your correspondence dated July 18, 2013 was received in this office on that date. You have requested certain records maintained by the Assembly; specifically:

- 1. The date Governor Cuomo's Program Bills #4, #5 and #12 were received by the Assembly Index Clerk. Please be advised that while index records are required to be made available for public inspection and copying pursuant to section 88 of the Public Officers Law (POL), the Assembly maintains no record responsive to this request. Please be advised that the Assembly can confirm receipt of these proposed bills, which are posted on the Governor's website at http://www.governor.ny.gov/sl2/legislation.
- 2. The Assembly Index Clerk's transmittal of these three Program Bills to Assembly leadership, offices, committees, or Assembly members for introduction and such action as they took thereto. Please be advised that there are no index records responsive to this request. In addition, correspondence to and from members and staff of the Assembly would not be required to be made available pursuant to either POL § 88 or Rule VIII of the Assembly Rules.
- 3. Assembly communications with the Senate pertaining to the status of Governor's Program Bills #4, #5 and #12 in that body. As noted above, any such communications would not be required to be made available pursuant to either POL §88 or Rule VIII of the Assembly Rules.

Based upon the foregoing, your requests for records are denied. I am enclosing for your review a copy of the statute and rule cited above, along with a copy of "A Guide to the Public Inspection and Copying of Legislative Records."
