Your Honor:

We represent respondent/defendant the Commission to Investigate Public Corruption (the "Commission") and defendants Kathleen Rice, William J. Fitzpatrick, and Milton L. Williams, Jr. in the above-referenced cases.

Based on public statements that the Moreland Commission is being disbanded as well as the fact that the Commission's staff has already been withdrawn and all of its documents have been provided to the United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York, the Co-Chairs of the Commission, Messrs. Fitzpatrick and Williams, have authorized us to inform the Court that the subpoenas *duces tecum* at issue in the above referenced matters have been withdrawn and directed us to withdraw the related motions to compel now that the issues raised therein are moot.

As a result, we respectfully request that the Court also dismiss the pending motions to quash, motions to intervene, and the declaratory-judgment complaint as moot, and close the above-referenced matters. We will be reaching out to counsel for petitioners/plaintiffs regarding this request.
