Dear Ms. Sassower:

I am in receipt of your letter dated March 29, 2007, requesting leave to serve and file an oversized brief not to exceed 14,900 words on the above-entitled appeals. The applicable rule requires that such an application be accompanied by a copy of the proposed brief (22 NYCRR 670.10.3[e]) in final form. The brief accompanying your letter is, according to your letter, 14,816 words in length. Accordingly, your application is granted to the extent of authorizing you to file an oversized brief not to exceed 14,816 words in length.
