- (1) The county's <u>own</u> calculations as to the dollar amounts of state aid for district attorney salary due it, pursuant to County Law §700.10, §700.11 – particularly as presented in its written, and presumably certified, requests for same filed with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, the Division of the Budget, and/or the State Comptroller;
- (2) the dollar amounts the county received as state aid for district attorney salary, pursuant to County Law §700.10, §700.11;
- (3) the dollar amounts the county received as state aid for district attorney salary, pursuant to any other law or language in budget bills.

As County Law §700.11 (c) makes state aid for district attorney salary, payable by the Comptroller "to the chief fiscal officer of each...[eligible] county during the month of September", please furnish a copy of the Comptroller's payment for <u>2016</u> upon its receipt.

Additionally, for <u>2017</u>, if the county has not yet submitted its written request for the state aid for district attorney salary to which County Law §700.10, §700.11 entitles it, please furnish same when it is made.
