In his written statement in support of his testimony at the Legislature's January 29, 2019 budget hearing on "public protection": http://nystateassembly.granicus.com/MediaPlayer.php?view_id=8&clip_id=4894, the Administrator/Counsel of the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct, Robert Tembeckjian, stated:

"In 2007, after two decades of chronic underfunding, the Assembly and Senate Judiciary Committees held public hearings and increased the Commission's budget from \$2.8 million to \$4.8 million." (page 3, at footnote 3).
