On February 15, 2019, we received your FOIL requests regarding oversight hearings of New York's district attorneys, the Commission on Judicial Conduct, and the New York State Attorney General.

Transcripts of public hearings may be accessed on our website at: <https://nyassembly.gov/av/hearings/>. Budget hearings are a tool that the legislature uses not only to determine future budgetary needs for entities but also to conduct oversight questioning. Those hearings are available and may provide the information that you are looking for. The State Library also has transcripts of Assembly hearings going back much further than the current Assembly website at: <http://www.nysl.nysed.gov/>.

Additionally, the Legislative Library has transcripts of two hearings that would be responsive to your specific requests. On September 22, 1987, the Judiciary Committee held a hearing on the Commission on Judicial Conduct. On October 29, 1987, the Judiciary Subcommittee on Court Structure held a hearing on attorney conduct, attorney discipline, and proposed sanctions. The transcripts of each of these hearings are approximately 500 pages. The estimated cost to copy these transcripts would be \$250.

We have not found any further responsive documents to your request. If we find any documents in the future, we will forward those to you promptly.
