

July 19, 2021 FOIL request – 2018 Senate & Assembly Concurrent Resolutions

“proposing that the constitution be amended by adding a new article V-A; in relation to state government integrity”

On April 30, 2018, Senator Krueger introduced Senate Concurrent Resolution #8309, which was committed to the Senate Judiciary Committee.

According to the Senate’s webpage for the resolution, <https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2017/S8309>, on May 18, 2018, it was referred to the Attorney General for opinion – and, on June 8, 2018, the opinion was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

On May 10, 2018, Assemblyman Carroll introduced Assembly Concurrent Resolution #10651, which was referred to the Assembly Committee on Governmental Operations.

According to the Senate’s webpage for the resolution, <https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2017/A10651>, on May 11, 2018, it was referred to the Attorney General for opinion – and, on June 7, 2018, the opinion was referred to the Assembly Judiciary Committee.

Pursuant to FOIL, this is to request: (1) a copy of the two requests to the Attorney General for opinions, including the transmitting letters/e-mails; and (2) the Attorney General’s two opinions – and any subsequent correspondence thereon.
