This is to record the fact that ten minutes ago, at 9:25 a.m., I recieved an offensive and insulting telephone call from a reader of your newspaper who told me that she was "sick and tired" of reading the kind of stories about Doris Sassower and her daughter that have been appearing in your paper.

She refused to identify herself, but told me she would "write an editorial" to the Gannett newspapers. Before I could even say anything in defense of myself or my mother, she hung up on me.

Immediately thereafter, I attempted to call the Metro Desk (694-5014)--but no one picked up the telephone.

Since I have to leave right now for work, I will be further in touch with you about today's latest example of your grossly defamatory and irresponsible journalism.
