today, Saturday, April 4, 1992.

This is to record the fact that at 12:50 p.m. today, I received a threatening telephone call from a man who stated that "the ways of the Sassowers will be bombed tonight at 6 p.m., fuck off".

I consider this threat to be a direct result of the deliberate smear campaign that Gannett has conducted against me. You have deliberately, and without justification, incited such hostility in the community as to now present a threat of physical harm to me and my family. We hold you responsible for the adverse consequences of today's false, distorted and defamatory story—as well as preceding ones of the same ilk.

The White Plains Police have already been notified. We request that your lawyers contact us <u>immediately</u> so that appropriate steps can be taken to deal with the dangerous situation which has been created by you.

My daughter called up Gannett at approximately 1:30 p.m. She confirmed with Mr. Kieran O'Leary, the editor in charge, that her faxed communication of 9:40 this morning had been received. She also related the foregoing telephone-threat to him.

You are hereby further put on notice that your continuing fraudulent and one-sided reporting of court proceedings constitutes a criminal contempt of court under Sec. 750(6) of the Judiciary Law.
