Update: The Assembly and Senate have sent a combined total of 150 bills to the Governor for his consideration. Our M/C Pay Commission Bill WAS NOT among them. We are in contact with the Assembly. The timing and packaging of the bills sent to the Governor is at the discretion of whichever house of the Legislature sends them - in our case, the Assembly, since it passed our bill first.

At this time, your letters to the Governor's Counsel, urging his (the Governor's) signature, can be sent to us via email (nysomce@gmail.com) or via the Postal Service (OMCE, 5 Pine West Plaza, Suite 513, Albany, NY 12205-5587), using a letter we recently mailed to all M/Cs or by crafting your own. OMCE will be hand-delivering these to the Governor's Counsel's Office to be sure they are timely placed with the bill, once it arrives for Executive consideration.

We see no timing problems with the commission actually being created, convening and rendering decisions, or with an April 2014 implementation date.

We will continue to update you here with the latest news as it becomes available.
