Dear Chief Judge Harris:

This follows up my phone conversation on Tuesday morning with your Judicial Assistant.

As my attorneys, Hoffman & Hoffman, P.A., will be moving to withdraw, I am effectively *pro se*, while I search for successor counsel, which I am already doing, assisted by a friend who has helped me write this letter.

On August 22, 2014, the Fifth District Court of Appeal issued an order relinquishing jurisdiction so that you could hold an evidentiary hearing on the August 13, 2014 Amended Motion for Relief from Court Orders, made on my behalf by Hoffman & Hoffman.

To prevent such evidentiary hearing from being held, Mr. Hennessey made an August 25, 2014 motion for reconsideration to the Fifth District Court of Appeal. My opposition was due on September 9th – and I filed and served it on that date. The last paragraph states:

“39. To avoid delay occasioned by Mr. Hennessey’s deceitful reconsideration motion, a copy of this affidavit is being deposited with the trial court so that, as contemplated by this Court’s August 22, 2014 order, it can hold the evidentiary hearing to which my Amended Motion for Relief shows a *prima facie* entitlement and then report its findings to this Court.”

Enclosed is a full copy of my opposition affidavit, particularizing Mr. Hennessey’s misrepresentations to the Fifth District Court of Appeal, including as to the state of the record before you. For your better assessment of the situation, a copy of Mr. Hennessey’s reconsideration motion (without appendix) is also enclosed.

¶¶24-34 of my affidavit largely replicate what I had hoped to submit to you, by affidavit, in opposition to Mr. Hennessey's motion to dismiss my amended complaint that had been calendared for an August 21, 2014 hearing. Enclosed is a copy of the August 21, 2014 affidavit I had furnished to Ms. Hoffman for deposit with the Court, but which, without explanation, she refused to submit.

The three exhibits to my August 21, 2014 affidavit are the same as Exhibits #1, #2, #3 to my September 9, 2014 affidavit to the Fifth District Court of Appeal, except that my "Procedural History", which is Exhibit #1 to my later affidavit, is more expanded. I, therefore, respectfully refer you to the "Procedural History" in my later affidavit.

I look forward to testifying before you at the evidentiary hearing on the Amended Motion for Relief.
