Dear Mr. Boggess:

The letter follows up my phone conversation with your office yesterday.

Lest the stenographer who is transcribing the Senate Judiciary Committee's November 29th hearing on Justice Graffeo's confirmation attribute to an anonymous "Voice" or "Person" a statement made by a member of the audience who rose to present citizen opposition immediately prior to the hearing's conclusion, I am that audience member. To enable you to confirm that Senate Judiciary Committee Chairman Lack was fully aware of my identity when he ignored my public request to present such opposition, a copy of this letter is being sent to him.

Chairman Lack and I spoke together just before the confirmation hearing began. In that conversation, Chairman Lack stated he would only allow me to submit written opposition — which I told him I had already done. So that that written opposition may be part of the permanent record, CJA hereby requests that Chairman Lack transmit it to the stenographer for inclusion with the permanent record of the Senate Judiciary Committee's hearing on Justice Graffeo's confirmation. This written opposition consists of: (1) CJA's November 21st letter to Chairman Lack, requesting an "invitation" to testify in opposition; and (2) CJA's November 13th letter to Chairman Lack and Justice Graffeo, transmitting to each of them copies of CJA's October 16th report and substantiating File Folders "A" and "B", as well as CJA's November 13th report.

Robert L. Schulz, Chairman of the We the People Foundation for Constitutional Education, Inc., has authorized me to also request that Chairman Lack transmit Mr. Schulz' written opposition for inclusion in the record. This consists of: (1) his October 30th letter to Chairman Lack, which was also addressed to Governor Pataki and Senate Majority Leader Bruno; and (2) his November 21st letter to David Gruenberg, Counsel to the Senate Judiciary Committee, memorializing the Committee's refusal to extend to him an "invitation" to testify in opposition.

Additionally, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Law (FOIL), CJA requests:

- (1) a copy of the transcript of the Senate Judiciary Committee's hearing on Justice Graffeo's confirmation;
- (2) a copy of the transcript of the debate and vote in the State Senate on Justice Graffeo's confirmation to the New York Court of Appeals;
- (3) a copy of the roll call of Senators voting on the question of Justice Graffeo's confirmation, as entered in the Senate Journal:
- (4) a copy of the certification of Justice Graffeo's confirmation, signed by the President and Secretary of the Senate.

Your prompt attention would be greatly appreciated. Please advise, by fax, as to the cost of this FOIL request -- which we will promptly remit.
