We were surprised to have had <u>no</u> response from the Civil Liberties Union to our transmittal of materials to you--under a September 13th coverletter. For your convenience, a copy of that coverletter is enclosed herewith.

We were also surprised to have had <u>no</u> response from the Civil Liberties Union to our October 26th Op-Ed advertisement in <u>The New York Times</u> describing the retaliatory suspension of my mother's license. A copy is also enclosed.

You should know that people are constantly asking us whether we have "gone to the Civil Liberties Union". They are shocked to hear that although we sent you a full set of papers more than two months ago, documenting how the Article 78 statute has been perverted by judges who refuse to recuse themselves from their own case, you have taken no action to stop this travesty. Indeed, they are incredulous to learn that you have not even gotten back to us.

As you know, time is fast running out for our <u>cert</u> petition to the U.S. Supreme Court. Please read <u>Mildner v. Gulotta--a</u> copy of which I sent you. That case reflects only the "tip of the iceberg" as to how unconstitutional New York's attorney disciplinary statute is.
