As the press will be interviewing you, in the coming weeks, about your candidacies – including for purposes of editorial endorsements – it is essential that you know what the press already knows – namely, that Suffolk County's 14 incumbent state legislators running for re-election or higher office must be indicted for fraud, larceny, and other corruption on EVIDENCE so *prima-facie* and open-and-shut as to assure their convictions. The particulars are set forth in the above two materially-identical public corruption/grand jury complaints, filed with Suffolk County District Attorney Sini and Nassau County District Attorney Singas, who are "sitting on" them.
