1a. In my opinion, no member of the Senate Judiciary Committee, nor anyone else, should be placed in the needlessly embarrassing position of asking Your Honor questions regarding PUCCINI CLOTHES, LTD., at the above hearings or thereafter.

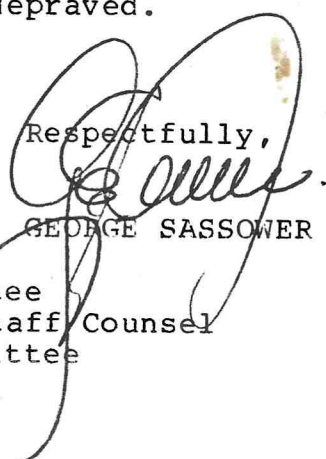
b. I suggest that Your Honor, on his own initiative, submit, without "fig leaves", a full and complete report on such involuntarily dissolved corporation, including Your Honor's conduct with respect to same.

2a. I have repeatedly stated that by law, I am required to "zealously" pursue my client's, as well as my own, legitimate interests, and be a "whistle blower" (Disciplinary Rule, 7-101, 1-103).

b. I intend to obey such professional mandates, if there is any default by Your Honor, in that regard.

c. My presentation will reveal that the judicial conduct in the Puccini matter, including by Your Honor's, has been criminal and ethically depraved.
