Gentlemen:

Enclosed please find a copy of my letter of October 15, 1991 to Director William S. Sessions, as well as my letter to the Grand Jury of the Eastern District of Missouri, dated April 12, 1991, which has still not been transmitted to that body.

You will note that in my communication intended for the Grand Jury, mention is made of Chief U.S. Circuit Court Judge Donald P. Lay, who was sent a copy of same.

Chief Judge Lay has never denied the allegations contained therein, and in the six months since April 12, 1991 the evidence of Chief Judge Lay's involvement has been augmented.

I draw your specific attention to the fact that the racket described therein includes diversion of monies payable "to the federal court" to private pockets.

The facts of this matter--all of which can be readily documented--warrant serious investigation.
