1. My enclosed letter to Chief Judge ***Jonathan Lippman***, dated January 18th, 2011, concluded as follows:

“I expect, by return mail, an unequivocal commitment by you to expeditiously *reimburse* the *State of New York & County of Westchester*.”

Although the obligation to *reimburse* has never been denied, there has been no response to my demand!

2. In the State & Federal courts in White Plains, ***Jonathan Lippman***, now the Chief Judge of the State of New York, was defended in his “*personal capacity*” by Assistant NY State Attorney Generals, at *unconstitutional* NY State cost & expense, in manifest violation of Article XIII §7 of the *New York State Constitution* and Amendment XI of the *Constitution of the United States* (*Hans v. Louisiana*, 134 U.S. 1 [1890]).

While admitting he was *defrauding* the State of New York, ***Jonathan Lippman*** arrogantly continued his course of misconduct, financially & otherwise!

3. As District Attorney ***Janet DiFiore*** is aware, an indictment or information filed against ***Jonathan Lippman*** would result in a stampede of judges & officials seeking to “*reimburse*” the *State of New York*, for *unconstitutional* expenditures made on their behalf over the past thirty-three (33) years!

Her failure is effectively an absolution for all other judges & officials *also* not to make “*reimbursement*” and license for the continuation of such criminally corrupt practices!

4. Since *only* the New York Legislature, which has “*exclusive*” control of the NY State “*purse*”, can waive or excuse “*reimbursement*”, in favor of the State of New York, the obligation of NY State Attorney General ***Eric T. Schneiderman*** is clear and has consequences (*NY Penal Law* §195).
