1. This affirmation is made in support of a motion to affirm Sassower v. Sheriff (651 F. Supp. 128 [SDNY]) based upon the criminal fraud on the Court by the appellants, the facts for which was confirmed on Friday, June 19, 1987 by Mr. HYMAN RAFFE ["Raffe"].

2a. In a separate mirrored Report, Referee DONALD DIAMOND, without a trial or hearing, had found Raffe to be in criminal contempt, on multiple counts, recommended that he be incarcerated and fined, similar to those recommendations made with respect to your affirmant.

b. Mr. Justice ALVIN F. KLEIN, another corrupt jurist, had also sentenced Raffe, SAM POLUR, Esq. ["Polur"], and your affirmant to be incarcerated, without benefit of trial, in one document.

c. Your affirmant served his full term under the; Klein conviction, and part of his term under the Diamond recommendation (see Sassower v. Sheriff, supra), Raffé never served a day of incarceration.

3a. IRA POSTEL, Esq. ["Postel"], had telephoned your affirmant and was told that FELTMAN, KARESH, MAJOR & FARBMAN, Esqs. ["FKM&F"] were "bleeding Raffé to death", "his life is being shortened", "I must stop", etc.

b. I agreed to a meeting with him and Mr. Raffé, which was held at Victoria Station, a restaurant, in White Plains, N.Y., on Friday, June 19, 1987.

c. Postel serves Raffé as Vidkun Quisling served Norway.

4a. At such meeting I was informed by Mr. Raffé of the continuing payments being made by him to FKM&F, and he promised that on Monday, June 21, 1987, he would send me copies of the invoices under which he made payments.

b. Mr. Raffé stated that he now regrets that he did not go to jail, rather than continuing to make these endless, blackmail, payments to FKM&F.

c. I told him that I entertained no doubt that they were unlawful, if not criminal, and could not be enforced if he stopped making such payments.

d. The corrupt judges, which FKM&F controlled, would directly or indirectly, impose larger sanctions against him, if he stopped making payments, was Mr. Raffe's response.

e. In very clear language, I told Mr. Raffe and Mr. Postel that I would never permit anyone, including Mr. Raffe, to serve as hostage, and would not cease my activities in exposing "the criminals" in FKM&F and Kreindler & Relkin, P.C. ["K&R"].

f. My demand that Raffe have returned to him all monies paid by him, or losses sustained by him, was simply not-negotiable, and would never be negotiable, as far as your affirmant was concerned.

g. There were conveyed threats made by FKM&F and K&R, through Mr. Postel, against your affirmant's children, and after consulting with the youngest of my three (3), my response is that "they can go to hell!

5a. It really does not concern me on what pre-text this or any corrupt court or judge incarcerates me, nor how many times I am again incarcerated without benefit of trial, I will never succumb.

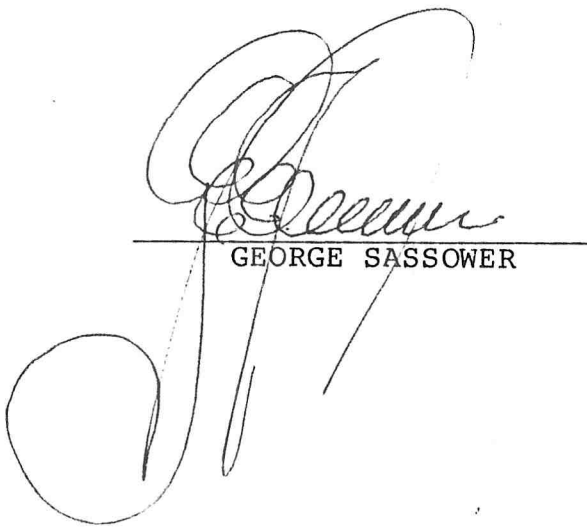
b. These "thieves" who now threaten my children, have the same depraved mentality as the "goose-steppers" that attempted to enslave the world one-half century ago.

c. To say more on the subject would be supererogatory.

6. The above is stated, under penalty of perjury.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed that the relief requested herein be granted in all respects.

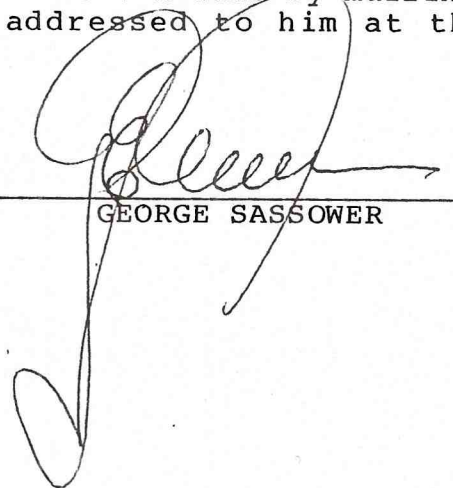
