Your Honors:

1a. If Your Honors desire to know why I am repeatedly incarcerated, without benefit of trial; or why Sam Polur, Esq., was also incarcerated with benefit of trial, based upon an uncorroborated, and undeniably false, accusatory affidavit; or why Hyman Raffé was literally bludgeoned in the Chambers of Referee Donald Diamond until he, inter alia, waived his right to demand an accounting or to object to same; I suggest Your Honors' request a copy of such accounting from Feltman, Karesh, Major, & Farbman, Esqs., or Senior Attorney, David S. Cook, Esq., or Chief Administrative Judge Joseph W. Bellacosa!

b. By happenstance, my attention was drawn to a legal notice in the New York Times which stated that an accounting for Puccini Clothes, Ltd., "the judicial fortune cookie", will be presented on October 30, 1986, before Referee Donald Diamond for settlement.

2a. According to the Feltman firm, a copy of such accounting was mailed to me three (3) weeks ago, which I never received, and which I, and about everyone else, believes was never sent.

b. When and if, I obtain a copy, with appropriate commentary, copies will be mailed to Your Honors, the media, the appropriate prosecuting authorities, the disciplinary organizations, the appropriate members of congress, the legislature, and interested groups, almost immediately.

3a. After six and one-half (6 1/2) years, an accounting is being rendered not because the law provides that it should be rendered within one (1) year; nor because the Attorney General obeyed his statutory mandate, and made application for such accounting, when not rendered after one and one-half (1 1/2) years (Bus. Corp. Law §1216); nor because any judge, state or federal, demanded that such "constitutional person" be given its constitutional rights; nor because basic constitutional rights were given by any state or federal judge to those interested in Puccini's affairs.

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b. An accounting is being rendered with respect to this "judicial fortune cookie" because everyone, including the judiciary, became convinced that it did not matter how many times I might be unjustly incarcerated, nor how times the writ of habeas corpus might be effectively suspended, nor how many opinions are written, that all "persons" enjoy basic constitutional rights, and if the judiciary defaults in respecting such mandated fundamental rights, such default would not serve as my excuse for disobedience to my sworn duty!

4a. I can assure Your Honors that I am incorrigible when it comes to the basic constitutional principles that in a courthouse all persons are equal, and each and every judge is duty bound to assure that every helpless person receives proper legal protection, whether it be a member of a minority group, or the infirm, or the involuntarily dissolved corporation.

b. I can assure Your Honors, that until anyone can find an American Judge, one single judge in the United States, who is willing to testify, under oath, that one can be constitutionally convicted, sentenced, and incarcerated for non-summary criminal contempt, without a trial, absent a plea of guilty, all the "garbage" which my adversaries have inudated Your Honors with, is without significance.

5a. This is my country, and my country will not have the courthouses controlled by "criminals with law degrees" or their stable of "hard core" corrupt jurists!

b. My country will not have courthouses, where fundamental constitutional and civilized rights are abrogated, simply because spineless and gutless judges subordinate those basic rights in favor of corrupt tyrants, robed and unrobed!

c. In my country, every person is entitled to a fundamentally fair trial, which means, more than anything else, an impartial jurist.

6a. The final settlement of the Puccini accounting, will not take place in the non-public courtroom of Referee Donald "pay-off" Diamond, nor will Rashba & Pokart be the accountants for such helpless judicial trust!

b. Rashba & Pokart, as investigatory accountants, were appointed "under color of law" by application of the receiver to investigate charges that Kreindler & Relkin, P.C. and the predecessor firm of Nachamie, Kirschner, Spizz, Levine & Goldberg, P.C. were engaged in the larceny of Puccini's judicial trust assets.

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No one disclosed that Kreindler & Relkin, P.C. were the clients of Rashba & Pokart, and that the Nachamie firm had unlawfully taken \$10,000 of Puccini's trust assets, "laundered" \$6,200 gave it to the Rashba firm in payment of an outstanding bill to the Kreindler firm, with the Nachamie firm retaining for itself \$3,800 as a "laundering fee"!

Rashba & Pokart were obviously retained to conceal the massive larceny that took place, not to reveal same, and still is.

7a. For the herculian fees awarded by the state judiciary to the Feltman firm, I would like to see \$5 worth of work or effort which was intended to benefit, or did benefit, their helpless judicial trust!

b. Those monies, direct and indirect, will be investigated, if not by an honest judge or judiciary, then by the media, and other authorities!

8a. One further point, the judiciary in my country does not tolerate, or remain silent, when a pariah, as is Referee Donald Diamond, orders and directs the Sheriff to "break-into" my premises, "seize all word processing and soft ware", and "inventory" my possessions!

b. My obedience is to the constitutional values of my country, and not to those who have been given the power, but not the authority, to incarcerate, without a trial, and plunder!

9. My ship may sink, but it will never strike its flag!
