Dear Mr. Sassower:

I am in receipt of your motion papers dated October 3, 1988 and October 20, 1988, respectively, re above-entitled matter.

In his affidavit in opposition to your motion dated October 3, 1988, Michael J. Gerstein, attorney for Citibank, N.A., alleges that Justice Ira Gammerman of the Supreme Court, New York County, by orders dated January 23, 1985 and March 11, 1986 permanently enjoined you from moving or intervening in the above-entitled matter. It appears that by said order dated March 11, 1986 Justice Gammerman also consolidated all existing and subsequently commenced Puccini related matters before him and stayed same. It also appears that order dated September 28, 1988 made by Special Referee Donald Diamond, appointed by Justice Riccobono, provides that the Clerks of all Courts in the Unified Court System of the State are not to accept any papers relating to the above-entitled action without leave in writing obtained from Justice Riccobono, or Justice Gammerman, or Special Referee Diamond.

Accordingly, I am herewith returning your motion papers to you.
