GEORGE SASSOWER, Esq., first being duly sworn,
deposes, and says:

1. This affidavit is in support of a motion to compel
the defendant LEE FELTMAN, Esq. ["Feltman"] to give obedience to
a levy made by the Sheriff of the City of New York (CPLR §5225,
§5227.

2. On April 29, 1982, deponent recovered a judgment
against PUCCINI CLOTHES, LTD. ["Puccini"], EUGENE DANN ["Dann"],
and ROBERT SORRENTINO ["Sorrentino"] in the sum of \$27,912.42.

3. On August 9, 1988, a levy with a restraining
notice, based on such judgment was delivered to the Sheriff of
the City of New York for service on Feltman (Sheriff's Case No.

42404).

4. On October 18, 1988, Counsel for the Sheriff of the City of New York advised deponent that although service was made on August 11, 1988 at 10:00 a.m. Feltman has failed and refused to comply with the demand made.

5. Feltman is the receiver for Puccini, holds its books, records, and assets and is able to comply with the demand of the Sheriff but has wilfully refused to obey same.

6. The obligations due deponent are constitutionally protected, and may not be impaired by the state or any officer thereof (U.S. Constitution, Article 1, §10).

7. Feltman, and his co-conspirators, are under the impression that simply because they have the ability to corrupt members of the judiciary, including Presiding Justice FRANCIS T. MURPHY and Administrator XAVIER C. RICCOBONO, they are above the law --- they are wrong!

8. Feltman and his co-conspirators have made the judicial trust assets of Puccini the subject of massive larceny and plundering, leaving nothing tangible for its stockholders and creditors.

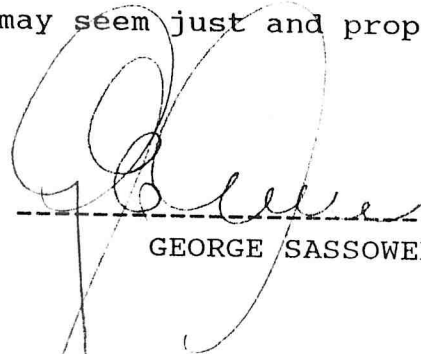
9. Consequently, although an accounting must be filed "at least once a year" (22 NYCRR 202.52[e], in the more than eight (8) years since Puccini was involuntarily dissolved, not a single accounting has been filed -- not one.

10. There is no possible way that a true accounting can be filed without dramatically disclosing the larceny,

plundering, extortion, and judicial corruption involved therein.

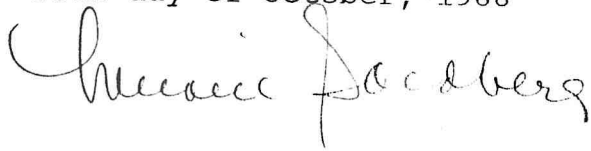
11. In any event, the aforementioned process served by the Sheriff must be obeyed.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed that an Order be entered directing Feltman to give obedience to the levy made upon him by the Sheriff of the City of New York, pursuant to CPLR, §5225, §5227, together with any other further, and/or different relief as to this Court may seem just and proper in the premises.
