Dear Justice Ruskin:

We are the attorneys for the court-appointed Receiver for Puccini Clothes, Ltd. ("Puccini"), a judicially dissolved corporation. My firm is denominated as a party defendant, as is Lee Feltman, Esq., Puccini's court-appointed Receiver.

We write in connection with the motion served upon us by disbarred attorney George Sassower, dated October 20, 1988 (and returnable before Your Honor on November 2, 1988), "seeking an order. . . directing compliance by Lee Feltman, Esq., with a levy made upon him by the Sheriff of the City of New York. . . on August 11, 1988 pursuant to CPLR § 5225, 5227. . ."

After attempting without success to ascertain whether these papers have actually been filed with the Clerk, we write to advise Your Honor of the series of Court Orders which require that the motion by Mr. Sassower be deemed a nullity and be returned to him.

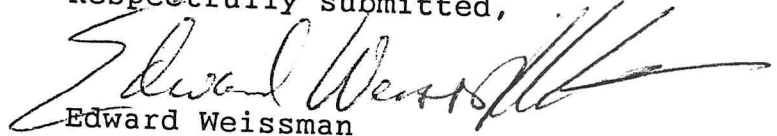

Mr. Sassower has been enjoined from commencing actions against the Receiver or in connection with the receivership of Puccini, and by an Order dated September 28, 1988 (copy enclosed), the Clerks of all New York State courts in the Unified Court System have been directed not to accept for filing any papers filed by Mr. Sassower in cases relating to Puccini, such as this action. Since we cannot ascertain whether Mr. Sassower actually filed these papers or may subsequently do so, we write to ask Your Honor's cooperation in enforcing that Order in the event Mr. Sassower's motion may have been inadvertently accepted for filing by the Motion Clerk or the Clerk of your Part. If the motion inadvertently was filed, we respectfully request that the motion papers be returned to Mr. Sassower.

Finally, pursuant to an Order dated March 11, 1986, a copy of which is enclosed, all pending and subsequently commenced proceedings relating to the Puccini matter were consolidated before Justice Ira Gamerman of the Supreme Court, New York County and are stayed. Said Order provides that Mr. Sassower's adversaries need not respond to any such litigation. Accordingly, we shall not submit a formal opposition to Mr. Sassower's motion.

I thank Your Honor for his time and consideration.
