deposes, and says:

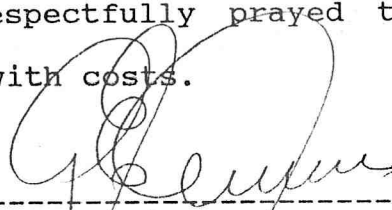
This affidavit is made in support of a motion to

since Citibank is jointly and severally liable for all damages

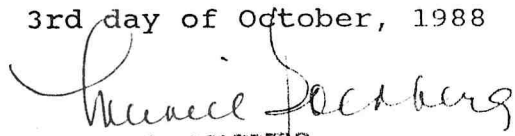
sustained by the plaintiff, Puccini.
