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O R D E R

For Writs of Mandamus and Prohibitions
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Petitioner, above-named, having moved this Court in his Third Cause of Petition for a Writ of Prohibition enjoining N.Y. State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS, acting under "color of law" from representing himself and others, in Westchester County, at state cost and expense, where the interests served are intended to be personal and contrary to legitimate sovereign interests; and it appears that there is a subject matter Eleventh Amendment constitutional infirmity by such representation in the federal courts, and legally unauthorized in this Court, and due service having been made of the Notice of Petition and Petition herein, and N.Y. State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS having defaulted, it is

ORDERED, that in the absence of any specific contrary order issued by a federal court regarding its jurisdiction, N.Y. State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS, and everyone acting in his behalf at state cost and expense, be and they are hereby enjoined from representing personal interests, in personal capacity actions and proceedings in the federal court in

Westchester County, as being violative of Amendment Eleventh of the United States Constitution, and it is further

ORDERED, that N.Y. State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS, or anyone on his behalf, be and they are hereby enjoined from representing private interests, in personal capacity actions and proceedings, in this Court, at state cost and expense, as legally unauthorized, and it is further

ORDERED, that the third cause of petition be and is hereby severed from the balance of the petition, which balance shall continue as viable causes of petition and subject to further Order of this Court.
