b. My filed RJ1 stated that this new action is related to the above proceeding.

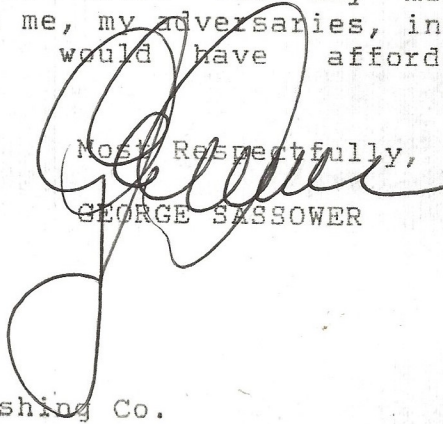
c. I consider the continued failure and refusal of my adversaries to retract or modify some of their statements and citations as a circumstance warranting further punitive damages.

2a. Since West, Lexis and/or Lawyer's Coop. never claimed First Amendment rights, their continuing re-publications of void decisions and opinions, causing constitutional damages, is clearly actionable (Wyatt v. Cole, 504 U.S. , 112 S.Ct. 1827 [1992]).

b. My repeated incarcerations and/or fines for non-summary criminal contempt, all without a trial, without the opportunity of a trial, without any confrontation rights, or live testimony in support thereof, should stand for the proposition that I refuse to involve myself in judicial corruption, irrespective of personal cost, and not of my guilt.

c. Needless to say if there was any merit to the repeated charges lodged against me, my adversaries, including the N.Y. State Attorney General, would have afforded me the opportunity for a trial.
