People like Mr. Lieto need help every 1 step of the way, it is unconscionable for an 2 elderly disabled gentleman to come home, 3 find his belongings in the front lawn and 4 pictures of his dead son torn to shreds. 5 We can do something SENATOR SAMPSON: 6 about that. 7 Yeah, because I need to MS. GKANIOS: add to that my mom's furnishings were in 9 this house. 10 This stuff was supposed to be put in 11 storage, instead the Sheriff's Office he 12 told me sue me. 13 Catherine Wilson was threatened, 14 attorney Ruth Pollack was threatened. This 15 is their attitude, sue me. 16 Tomorrow this case goes back before 17 Judge DeBello, there is a motion before him 18 to vacate the judgment of foreclosure and 19 sale. 20 There was no notices, no affidavits, 21 Catherine Wilson will tell you and I will 22 tell you in an average foreclosure there has 23

got to be a dozen Affidavits of Service.

In Dominic's case it was only one, I 1 kept my -- my house was in foreclosure for 2 10 years, over 225 motions I personally 3 filed. 4 So I ripped this case apart along with 5 Catherine Wilson, she did the financial end 6 of it, I did the other part of it, because 7 nobody is going to tell me a foreclosure 8 inside out. 9 So this --10 So you have SENATOR SAMPSON: 11 foreclosures -- that woman kept a 12 foreclosure open for 10 years. 13 MS. GKANIOS: You didn't let me 14 finish, 10 years, do you know a lawyer came 15 up to me and said to me how do I know that 16 this was done right? 17 He says could you pay me \$25,000 to 18 read it? 19 Listen, if you want to know how I did 20 it, you go to the courthouse and dig up the 21 thing and you read my papers. 22 SENATOR SAMPSON: Thank you very 23 much. 24

20	Exchange, Assistant General Counsel to a
21	securities firm on Wall Street and also head
22	of market surveillance for that particular
23	firm.
24	When I left and went to
