The petition as filed contained 516 signatures. The number of signatures required was 454. Since 77 specific objections were sustained leaving only 439 valid signatures remaining, the petition is found to contain an insufficient number of valid signatures and is, therefore, ruled to be invalid.

Accordingly, the name Terry Jane Ruderman will not appear on the primary ballot as a candidate of the Conservative Party for the public office of Judge of the Family Court.
