Dear Mr. Kinsella:

It is now almost three months since we first sought information from the Senator's office relative to: (a) the basis for Senator D'Amato's recommendation of Mr. O'Rourke for a federal judgeship; (b) the names of the individuals comprising the Senator's judicial screening panel; and (c) the procedures employed in the screening. To date, we have heard nothing from the Senator—notwithstanding our several telephone calls and two letters.

Indeed, our second letter, dated January 7, 1992, was expressly addressed to <u>your</u> attention and complained of what was then a lapse of seven weeks <u>without</u> a reply from anyone in the

So as to expedite your response to the rather straightforward information we seek, we <u>again</u> enclose our past correspondence.
