Dear Chairman DeFrancisco,

I have been waiting for written confirmation of the telephonic advice I just received that, following your acknowledged receipt of my letter requesting your reconsideration, you have again DENIED my and my daughter Elena's request to testify at tomorrow's hearing on the Kaye confirmation.

She promised to send me an email for that effect, as I told her I would not otherwise cancel my previously made travel plans. Meantime, Ms. Luther stated that I could email a copy of my intended written testimony to you for your inclusion in the record of tomorrow's hearing. I do so now in order that you can judge the serious and substantial nature of the evidence that I wish to present, which further reinforces my daughter's testimony on behalf of CJA, a copy of which you have already received.

I am also awaiting word from Ms. Luther as to my request to know whether you would permit my testimony to be heard at the Public Hearing, if Mr. Vigliano were to yield his permitted time to me. Or whether you have arbitrarily decided to bar all Sassowers from giving your Committee the benefit of their opposing views.

By the way, are there any written standards or criteria for determining who shall be invited to speak at your Public Hearing? Or is it strictly subject to the Chairman's whim and caprice?
