You have recently requested additional records from the Assembly. Specifically, you have requested "records of legislative hearings on the Legislature's own budgets and/or on the Governor's budget bills making appropriations for the Legislature within the last 25 years."

As I noted in previous correspondence, the function of this office is to respond to requests for records maintained by the Assembly, not to conduct historical research. If you wish, you may contact the State Library for such purpose. In relation to records maintained by the Assembly, no such records have been located.

I recently provided you with a copy of Public Officers Law §88 and Rule VIII of the Assembly Rules, as well as the brochure, "A Guide to the Public Inspection and Copying of Legislative Records."
