Dear Ms. Sassower,

I wanted to provide you with some additional information as to further costs that we are entitled to based on the appellate proceedings.

The Judgment that was entered in 2011 dealt strictly with the lower court (Supreme Court) proceedings. Pursuant to New York law, and expressly stated in the Second Department decisions dated August 21, 2013 and December 5, 2013, we are entitled to additional costs for the appellate proceedings. The costs we will be seeking for the initial appeal to the Second Department total \$904.56: \$250 pursuant to CPLR 8203, and an additional \$654.56 for the appellate printing costs we incurred.

Also, the Second Department awarded an additional \$100 costs in their decision on your motion to reargue.

All together, these costs total \$1,004.56. Please let me know if you would like to satisfy these costs prior to us drafting and entering a subsequent judgment in Suffolk County.
