I remain uncomfortable discussing legal issues with a pro se plaintiff, and I am unclear on your attorney's role in this matter. If the action is, as it appears, time-barred and frivolous, we will of course seek sanctions from the court against any attorneys who assisted in commencing the action.

But to make clear my prior answer to your questions: The individuals you mention have not authorized anyone in the Legal Department to accept service on their behalf or to provide plaintiffs with their addresses. Your attorney will no doubt advise you on how to serve employees through their place of employment under the CPLR.
