## TO: Tim Derocher, Legislative Director to Assembly Ways & Means Ranking Member Edward Ra, Esq.

Thank you for giving me an opportunity to summarize for you the unconstitutionality and unlawfulness of the New York State budget, laid out in the ten causes of action of CJA's citizen-taxpayer action, now before the Court of Appeals, whose record – as I showed you – is fully posted on CJA's website, <a href="https://www.judgewatch.org">www.judgewatch.org</a>, accessible from the prominent center link "CJA's Citizen-Taxpayer Actions to END NYS' Corrupt Budget 'Process' and Unconstitutional 'Three Men in a Room' Governance".

As discussed, the two-fold purpose of my call was: (1) to inquire whether the Ways & Means Minority – headed by Assemblyman Ra – has put out its "Green Book" – and, if so, to request a copy, or – at very least, the pages pertaining to the Judiciary and Legislative budgets and the portion of "public protection" pertaining to district attorneys, especially as relates to "salary reimbursement"; and (2) to inquire whether Assemblyman Ra is familiar with CJA's citizen-taxpayer action and my advocacy with respect thereto, as I have no recollection of having directly communicated with his office previously about it. I have no memory of having e-mailed him recently, other than by the below July 16, 2019 e-mail, whose above attached analysis of the December 10, 2018 report of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation largely revolves around the dispositive, *prima facie* proof presented by the citizen-taxpayer action.

It is not difficult to accomplish, especially if he would use the "bully pulpit" of his leadership to "whistleblow", as required by ethical and professional rules and is the duty he owes his constituents and the People of the State of New York.

As you know, the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation preserved your stipends in recognition of the "significantly more work" and "additional duties" you are expected to perform (at p. 19). That Report is a fraud on the People of the State of New York and larceny of their tax dollars – and the particulars are set forth by the above-attached analysis of the Report.

This is to give you NOTICE of what you should already know: that the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative & Executive Compensation that boosted your salaries is a <u>fraud</u> upon the People of the State of New York – and a <u>larceny</u> of their tax dollars.

To assist you in belatedly discharging your responsibilities to protect the People you were elected to serve, attached is the Center for Judicial Accountability's formal NOTICE to you, transmitting an analysis of the December 10, 2018 Report.
