## TO: Assembly Records Access Officer Robin Marilla

Pursuant to Assembly Rule VIII ("Public Access to Records"), this is to request a pdf of the "Green Book" of the Republican Assembly Minority constituting its review and analysis, by its Counsel and Ways and Means Committee staff, of the Governor's fiscal year 2020-21 state budget.

I hereby also request that the "Green Book" be posted on the Assembly's webpages for the budget: <a href="https://nyassembly.gov/2020budget/">https://nyassembly.gov/2020budget/</a>, which should feature a tab for the "Green book", just as it has a tab for the Democratic Assembly Majority "Yellow book". Alternatively, the tab should be renamed to "Counsel/Staff Analyses" – and open to a page where both the "Yellow Book" and "Green Book" are accessible.

Earlier this morning, I spoke with Tim Derocher, Legislative Director to Assembly Ways & Means Committee Ranking Member Ra – following up on our phone conversation on Wednesday, January 29, 2020 (518-455-4627). He stated that he would provide me with a copy of the "Green Book", when it is available. I understood him to mean that it has not yet been completed and distributed to the Assembly Republican Minority. I requested, additionally, that Ranking Member Ra take steps to have the "Green Book" posted on the Assembly's webpages for the budget – and, at very least, that he post the "Green Book" on his own Assembly webpage: <a href="https://nyassembly.gov/mem/Edward-P-Ra">https://nyassembly.gov/mem/Edward-P-Ra</a>, much as Senate Finance Committee Ranking Member Seward has posted the Senate Minority's "White Book" on his: <a href="https://www.nysenate.gov/senators/james-l-seward-https://www.nysenate.gov/newsroom/articles/2020/james-l-seward/analysis-2020-21-governors-budget-proposal.">https://www.nysenate.gov/newsroom/articles/2020/james-l-seward/analysis-2020-21-governors-budget-proposal.</a>
