This follows up my phone conversation, earlier this afternoon, with Deanna, at your district office (315-793-9072).

Your yesterday's public statement "'Bare-bones' state budget must be done", reported by the Utica Observer-Dispatch "Griffo calls for 'bare-bones' NY budget" and by WKTV-News Channel 2 "Griffo Urges Cuomo To Remove Controversial Items From The State Budget", urges Governor Cuomo to avoid a "budget laden with policy", calling it "irresponsible" during this coronavirus crisis.

#### Why have you NOT asserted that Governor Cuomo's policy-packed budget is UNCONSTITUTIONAL?

Did you not read CJA's above-attached March 18, 2020 letter to Governor Cuomo on that subject, entitled "GOOD NEWS DURING THE CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY: You Can Chuck 6 of the 7 'Article VII Bills' Because They are Unconstitutional. Here's why...". It analyzes the Governor's "Article VII Bills" for FY2020-21 and does so in the context of the Court of Appeals' seminal 2004 decision in Pataki v. Assembly/Silver v. Pataki, 4 NY3d 75, providing what appears to be the FIRST scholarship deconstructing its plurality, concurring, and dissenting opinions.

As reflected by the below, I e-mailed the letter to you – and to your legislative director – twice last week, on March 18th and then, again, on March 20th.

Unless you deny or dispute the accuracy of the analysis contained therein, you already have the "bare-bones" state budget you purport to want.

### Wouldn't the Senate and Assembly minority be more effective in protecting minority rights if they explained what the New York State Constitution says and insisted on adherence to its provisions?

Finally, and as I pointed out to Deanna, there is a further reason why CJA's March 18, 2020 letter should be of particular interest to you. Its sole enclosure - CJA's above-attached August 21, 2013 letter to Governor Cuomo entitled "Achieving...a Properly Functioning Legislature..." - discusses (at pp. 4-6) the 2009 Temporary Senate Committee on Rules and Administration Reform, three of whose nine members remain in the Senate: yourself, Senator Kevin Parker, and the Senate's now Majority Leader Andrea Stewart-Cousins, who happens to be my own state senator.

I am available to assist you, to the max, in discharging the duty to which you swore, by your oath of office (Article XIII, §1), to uphold the New York State Constitution. Such benefits ALL the People of the State of New York. Please feel free to call me with any questions.
