## TO: <u>Records Access Officers</u> for the Senate, for the Assembly, for the Governor, for the Division of the Budget

This FOIL request is necessitated by the non-responsiveness of the <u>New York State Independent</u> <u>Redistricting Commission</u> to my below two e-mails to its co-executive directors, its deputy coexecutive directors, and its two directors of public engagement, sent at 10:17 am on Friday, February 10<sup>th</sup> and 9:38 am on Monday, February 13<sup>th</sup> – with the latter e-mail also sent to its two assistant directors of engagement.

Pursuant to FOIL [Public Officers Law Article VI, Senate Rule XIV, Assembly Rule VIII], this is to request all publicly-accessible records reflecting:

- (1) why the Legislature's FY2022-23 budget that Temporary Senate President Stewart-Cousins and Assembly Speaker Heastie transmitted to Governor Hochul by their <u>December 1, 2022 coverletter</u> included (at pp. 1, 6, 10) the <u>Independent</u> <u>Redistricting Commission</u> – and, likewise, why their <u>December 1, 2021 coverletter</u> to Governor Hochul, transmitting the Legislature's FY2022-23 budget included (at pp. 1, 6, 10) the Independent Redistricting Commission;
- (2) why, for FY2021-22, the behind-closed-doors "three people in a room" consisting of Governor Cuomo, Temporary Senate President Stewart-Cousins, and Assembly Speaker Heastie popped a \$4,000,000 appropriation for the Independent Redistricting Commission into their March 30, 2021 and April 3, 2021 amendings of the legislative portion of the FY2021-22 Legislative/Judiciary appropriation bill, moving it from the State Operations appropriation bill, where Governor Cuomo had originally placed it;
- (3) whether, prior to the FY2021-22 budget, any appropriations were made for the Independent Redistrict Commission and, if so, by which bills;
- (4) why, since redistricting is every ten years, is the FY2023-24 appropriation for the Independent Redistricting Commission back to the \$4,000,000 appropriated in FY2021-22 – represented, by the Legislature's FY2023-24 budget (at p. 1) as being a "restoration...to a full fiscal year of activity";

- (5) how the \$4,000,000 was calculated as being needed for FY2023-24, considering, in the <u>FY2022-23 Legislative/Judiciary appropriation bill</u> (at p. 63), there was a whopping \$2,641,106 left over for "reappropriation" from the FY2021-22 appropriation of \$4,000,000;
- (6) Why, since the <u>FY2023-24 Legislative/Judiciary appropriation bill</u> (at pp. 71-72) contains \$2,838,050 left over for "reappropriation" from FY2021-22 and FY2022-23, those reappropriated funds were not deducted from the \$4,000,000 needed for the Independent Redistricting Commission for FY2023-24, if it was actually needed.
