Dear Elena Sassower,

The NYS Office of Children and Family Services received a FOIL request from you on February 12, 2024. You requested:

"Pursuant to FOIL, this is to request all records establishing:

(1) why the "New York State Citizen Review Panels for Child Protective Services", established by Social Services Law §371-B, has a non-governmental website, ending in org (www.citizenreviewpanelsny.org), rather than a governmental website, ending in gov;

(2) why "the administrative support to the Panels" is provided by "WRI Solutions, through a grant from the New York State Office of Children and Family Services" – so-stated at the bottom of each webpage;

(3) the date and amount of each "grant" to "WRI Solutions" for its "administrative support" – presumably the same as the "contract" identified as "Additional Information" on the webpage pertaining to "Recruitment" – and a copy of such "contract(s)".

Additionally, this is to request the "orientation materials" that WRI provides to "newly-appointed members for review" – identified on the "Recruitment" webpage, for which there is also posted a "printable version" pdf.
