

Details of the February 11, 2021 Complaint
against Assistant Solicitor General Frederick Brodie

Assistant Solicitor General Frederick Brodie was the attorney assigned by the office of then Attorney General Underwood to defend against the plaintiff-appellants' appeal of the citizen-taxpayer action *Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. v. Cuomo...Schneiderman...DiFiore* (Albany Co. #5122-16) at the Appellate Division, Third Department and by the office of Attorney General James to defend against their appeal before the Court of Appeals. Having NO legitimate defense, he engaged in litigation fraud before both those courts – and was rewarded with fraudulent judicial decisions by judges who were without jurisdiction to render them by reason of their financial and other interests, proscribed by Judiciary Law §14 and Court of Appeals' caselaw, beginning with *Oakley v. Aspinwall*, 3 NY 547 (1850). This is particularized by plaintiff-appellants' submissions to those courts, furnishing line-by-line "legal autopsies"/analyses of his filings and of his oral advocacy on August 2, 2018 and November 3, 2018 before the Appellate Division, Third Department – and of the judicial decisions.

Exhibits E and D to the February 11, 2021 complaint furnish inventories of these submissions at the Appellate Division, Third Department and at the Court of Appeals, respectively. This is further reinforced – and amplified – by plaintiff-appellants' February 7, 2021 judicial misconduct complaint, filed with the Commission on Judicial Conduct, enclosed with the February 11, 2021 complaint (at p. 10).
