 13 Payment of state aid for expenses of the
 14 special narcotics prosecutor 825,000
 15 For payment of state aid for expenses of
 16 crime laboratories for accreditation,
 17 training, capacity enhancement and lab
 18 related services to maintain the quality
 19 and reliability of forensic services to
 20 criminal justice agencies, distributed
 21 through a competitive process, which
 22 includes an evaluation of the effective-
 23 ness of such process. Some of these funds
 24 herein appropriated may be transferred to
 25 state operations and may be suballocated
 26 to other state agencies 6,635,000
 27 For payment of state aid for Westchester
 28 county policing program 1,984,000
 29 For reimbursement of the services and
 30 expenses of municipal corporations, public
 31 authorities, the division of state police,
 32 authorized police departments of state
 33 public authorities or regional state park
 34 commissions for the purchase of ballistic
 35 soft body armor vests, such sum shall be
 36 payable on the audit and warrant of the
 37 state comptroller on vouchers certified by
 38 the commissioner of the division of crimi-

 43 vests. A portion of these funds may be
 44 transferred to state operations and may be
