The "Legislature's" Declaratory Judgment Action vs the Commission to Investigate Public Corruption -- & US Attorney Bharara's Subpoening of JCOPE Complaints

New York taxpayers paid the lawyers on <u>both</u> sides to brief the constitutional, separation of powers issues in the "Legislature"'s declaratory judgment action against the Commission to Investigate Public Corruption. Those issues are NOT moot. To the contrary, their seriousness has been reinforced by the past month's events.

For this reason, and to secure the judicial determination of the constitutional, separation of powers issues to which New Yorkers are entitled, I have moved to intervene on behalf of the People of the State of New York & the Public Interest in the "Legislature's" declaratory judgment action against the Commission. The intervention motion, filed April 23rd, chronicles the corruption and fraud of <u>both</u> sides, protecting and colluding with each other, and is posted on the Center for Judicial Accountability's website, <u>www.judgewatch.org</u>, accessible from the prominent homepage link: "Intervening on behalf of the People of the State of New York & the Public Interest for a Declaration of Unconstitutionality, Etc.". In light of U.S. Attorney Bharara's subpoenaing of all complaints filed with JCOPE, I suggest you examine Exhibit B-6 to the proposed verified complaint that is part of the intervention motion, as it is the fact-specific, fully-documented June 27, 2013 ethics/corruption complaint I filed with JCOPE against Governor Cuomo, Attorney General Schneiderman, Comptroller DiNapoli, Temporary Senate President Skelos, Assembly Speaker Silver, etc. for "grand larceny of the public fisc and other corrupt acts" – and rests on the fact-specific, fully-documented April 15, 2013 corruption complaint against them that I filed 2-1/2 months earlier with U.S. Attorney Bharara.

As highlighted by my intervention motion, I alerted the Commission to Investigate Public Corruption again, and again, and again, to the fact that JCOPE was sitting on the June 27, 2013 ethics/corruption complaint, that US Attorney Bharara was sitting on the April 15, 2013 corruption complaint, and that ALL investigative, oversight, enforcement officers and entities were similarly sitting on corruption complaints filed with them against the Governor, Attorney General, Comptroller, Temporary Senate President, Assembly Speaker, etc. relating to that same "grand larceny of the public fisc and other corrupt acts".
