Dear Dan –

Just to remind you, I am available – and eager – to speak with you about the below. Surely, you have questions.

Have you already, or will you be, questioning the seven members of the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation about my November 4th testimony and subsequent correspondence? How about Chief Administrative Judge Marks and the other judicial pay raise witnesses who testified at that hearing and the November 14th hearing? If they deny or dispute anything – and I take pride in being accurate – I am ready to respond, WITH EVIDENCE.

On the subject of accuracy, I take this opportunity to slightly revise my November 4th testimony wherein I stated that “most [of the Commissioners] are afflicted by conflicts of interests” [Tr. 70]. In fact, ALL the Commissioners suffer from disqualifying conflicts of interest and demonstrated bias – except possibly one, Commissioner Madonia, ironically the sole Commissioner not physically or electronically present at the November 4th hearing.
