It's EASY for Governor Cuomo and Legislators to simplify the policy-packed NYS budget during this coronavirus emergency. This is laid out by the Center for Judicial Accountability's attached March 18, 2020 letter to the Governor entitled "**GOOD NEWS DURING THE CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY: You Can Chuck 6 of the 7 'Article VII Bills' Because They are Unconstitutional. Here's why...**". It analyzes the Governor's "Article VII Bills" for FY2020-21 and does so in the context of the Court of Appeals' seminal 2004 decision in *Pataki v. Assembly/Silver v.
