Niagara County's five state legislators – four of whom are seeking re-election – are the subjects of a **fully-documented** public corruption/grand jury complaint, filed with Niagara County District Attorney Wojtaszek, who is seeking election as Niagara County judge and "sitting on" it. Among other things, the complaint involves the "force of law" commission/committee scheme that has given pay raises to all of them – and to judges.

The June 18, 2020 complaint, by the Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA), is above-attached – and below are the e-mails transmitting it and the also attached July 27, 2020 FOIL request to D.A. Wojtaszek. CJA's substantiating evidentiary webpage for the complaint is here: <u>http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/2020-legislative/grand-juries.htm</u>.

As stated by the complaint, Niagara County voters are entitled to know that <u>their state legislators are</u> unfit for re-election because they must be indicted for larceny and other corruption on EVIDENCE so <u>DISPOSITIVE as to assure convictions.</u>

To enable Niagara County voters to assess, <u>for themselves</u>, the open-and-shut, *prima facie* EVIDENCE that D.A. Wojtaszek has been withholding from a Niagara County grand jury to maintain her own fraudulently-boosted salary, paid by Niagara County taxpayers – and the fraudulently-boosted salary she wants to get as a judge – please accompany your story with links to the complaint and the evidentiary webpage.

As you will doubtless call the complained-against five state legislators and D.A. Wojtaszek for comment about the complaint, I am cc'ing them on this e-mail so that they can be prepared. What, if anything, do they deny or dispute. Let them start where the complaint starts: <u>my July 16, 2019 e-mail to the</u> Legislature's 15 stipend-receiving leaders requesting that they forward it to the 198 other legislators, with its attached July 15, 2019 written NOTICE and substantiating analysis that the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation – raising their legislative salaries from \$79,500 to \$110,000 – was "'a fraud on the People of the State of New York – and a larceny of their tax dollars', violating a succession of penal laws, and that their duty was to void it, to return the pay-raise monies they had already received, and to initiate criminal prosecutions of the Committee's four members and abetting attorneys." The analysis is 46 pages, excluding <u>exhibits</u>. Will the five legislators – four lawyers and including a former judge – furnish you with their findings of fact and conclusions of law? How about D.A. Wojtaszek? If not, I'm sure ordinary Niagara County citizens would be able to help you with what is <u>obvious</u>.

I am available to answer your questions and assist you, <u>to the max</u> -- on a story not only upending Niagara County's state legislative races, the Niagara County D.A. race, and D.A. Wojtaszek's candidacy to be a Niagara County Court judge -- but, additionally, ALL New York's other state legislative races and its 14 other D.A. races – and **that's for starters**.
