This follows the voice mail message I left for you a short time ago (202-670-7729).

Accuracy in Media, Inc. (AIM) has an important role to play in the unfolding NPR, PBS, and CPB lawsuits against President Trump. This is evident from its lawsuit, *Accuracy in Media, Inc. v. Federal Communications Commission and United States*, [521 F.2d 288 \(D.C. Cir 1975\)](#), *cert denied*, [425 US 934 \(1976\)](#), pertaining to §396(g)(1)(A) of the Public Broadcasting Act requiring “strict adherence to objectivity and balance in all programs or series of programs of a controversial nature”.

Above-attached is my June 27th letter to the Justice Department about the NPR, PBS, and CPB lawsuits – and the unconstitutionality of the Public Broadcasting Act “by reason of the corruption of CPB’s ‘internal governance and operations’ and the absence of congressional oversight”.
