MESSAGE:

Governor Cuomo's letter of October 28, 1991 to Mr. Miller and Mr. Marino stated:

"...we have heard from judges, court personnel, lawyers and outside observers about the rampant waste in our judicial system. These reports, although troubling, are not surprising, because we have all believed for a long time that the courts are inefficient..." (emphasis added)

Our October 24, 1991 letter--faxed to Governor Cuomo on that date--attributes the present crisis in the courts not merely to the "well established" fact that the courts are inefficient, but to reasons underlying that inefficiency: incompetent and corrupt judges--including those who have been Governor Cuomo's political backers.

Governor Cuomo's letter to the legislative leaders--four days after his office's receipt of our letter to him--wholly ignores our contentions--all of which we stated were documentable, as well as matters of public record.
