Enclosed is our June 2, 1992 letter to Senate Majority Leader Mitchell, transmitting our May 26th letter to City Bar President Feerick--which you received from us last week.

We suggest that if you have any doubts as to the seriousness of what our critique to the Senate Judiciary Committee documents, you place a call to the American Bar Association and City Bar for their views.

Your examination of our critique will leave no doubt in your mind that the only screening that took place by those organizations was the screening out of adverse information that the most cursory investigation would have exposed.

Since, apparently, you don't recognize the importance of our call for a moratorium of all further Senate confirmations of judicial nominees, we enclose herewith your newspaper's editorials of May 7th and May 31st--which perhaps you missed.

We believe this news eminently "fit to print"--and that this is not just a local story. However, as a local story, the public is entitled to know the kind of scandalous misrepresentations and outright lies made by our Westchester County Executive. Based upon what we documented, it is safe to assume that this nomination will never come up for a hearing because Mr. O'Rourke and everyone connected with his nomination are praying that what we have uncovered will not gain media attention--which, otherwise, it clearly would.
