ARBITRATORS JUDGMENT

is as follows:

Claim to motion to vacate pursuant to CPLR § 7511 is denied. By virtue of the fact that the arbitrator dismissed the claim (and the counterclaim) claimant contends that the arbitrator must have been biased, partial and retaliating.
